



The Monastery of St. Gertrude shares in the physical, emotional, and spiritual hardships endured by so many this past year. We eagerly desire to resume offering healing hospitality, grateful simplicity, and creative peacemaking. As caregivers, we strongly encourage all eligible people to receive a vaccination. With compassion, we acknowledge that a number of situations preclude a person from being vaccinated. Holding these realities in tension, informed by the CDC, State and Local guidelines, and out of ongoing concern for the health and safety of our guests, staff, and community, the Monastery of St. Gertrude commits to the following measures in order to welcome guests back in our sacred space.

We ask all visitors to:

- Reschedule your visit if you:
 - a. feel sick (not limited to COVID-19 symptoms)
 - b. have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to your visit
- Wear a mask in all public areas except when eating meals or outside
- Maintain 6 feet of physical distance from others at all times
- Wash or sanitize your hands often
- Cover coughs and sneezes

The Monastery of St. Gertrude will:

- Disinfect public use areas and items regularly
- Place hand sanitizing stations throughout the buildings
- Require sisters and employees to wear masks when interacting with guests

The Inn at St. Gertrude will:

- Offer only single occupancy reservations unless both individuals reside at the same home address
- Require guests to initial and sign a COVID-19 Expectations Agreement upon arrival
- Offer Breakfast – served in the Wren Room at 7:00 am.
 - 1. We will supply hand sanitizer and gloves for serving
- Thoroughly clean guest rooms between stays

COVID-19 Expectations Agreement

I acknowledge that:

- The Monastery of St. Gertrude and its ministries are following official guidelines to reduce the likelihood of exposure to COVID-19.
- Preventative measures do not fully eliminate the risk of contracting and spreading COVID-19 or other diseases.
- Individuals I encounter while traveling to or visiting the Inn may be:
 - a. Unvaccinated
 - b. Asymptomatic
- I knowingly choose to visit the Inn at St. Gertrude Initials _____

For 14 days prior to visiting the Inn at St. Gertrude, I have not:

- Tested positive for COVID-19
- Been in contact with someone with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19. Today, I feel well, free of all symptoms not attributed to a known, preexisting condition. Initials _____

While at the Inn at St. Gertrude, out of compassion for all guests, staff, and community members,

I agree to:

- Wear a mask in all public areas except when eating meals or outside
- Maintain a 6-feet of physical distance from others at all times
- Wash or sanitize my hands often
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- If I develop any symptoms of illness
 - a. Isolate from all other individuals
 - b. Inform my host
 - c. Depart the premises as soon as practical
 - d. Seek medical attention as necessary
